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Recently a newsletter dated December 12, 1995 was issued explaining Liberty Health benefits to those individuals in Groups 2672T/2672P.

Please be advised that those employees who commenced employment after January 1, 1948 do not qualify to enter Group 2672P at age 65. At age 65 these pensioners will not have any health benefits with Liberty Health and must obtain their health benefits from the Government of Ontario.

Any one employed prior to 1948 with at least 20 years of service will, upon age 65, maintain coverage with The Government of Ontario and also transfer to Group 2672P with Liberty Health.
