MROO Open Enrolment Insurance Benefits Program

MROO – Municipal Retirees Organization of Ontario and their insurance partner **VICTOR** has introduced an open enrolment period from September 1st to October 31st. If you are 65 or older and have lost your City provided benefits, this is a chance to get extended health care, dental and travel insurance without having to answer any medical questions. The age limitation is age 50 to 75 and benefits are guaranteed for life as long as premiums remain in good standing. Also, if you do sign-up with the program, MROO is extending a free lifetime membership to MROO, a \$25 value.
